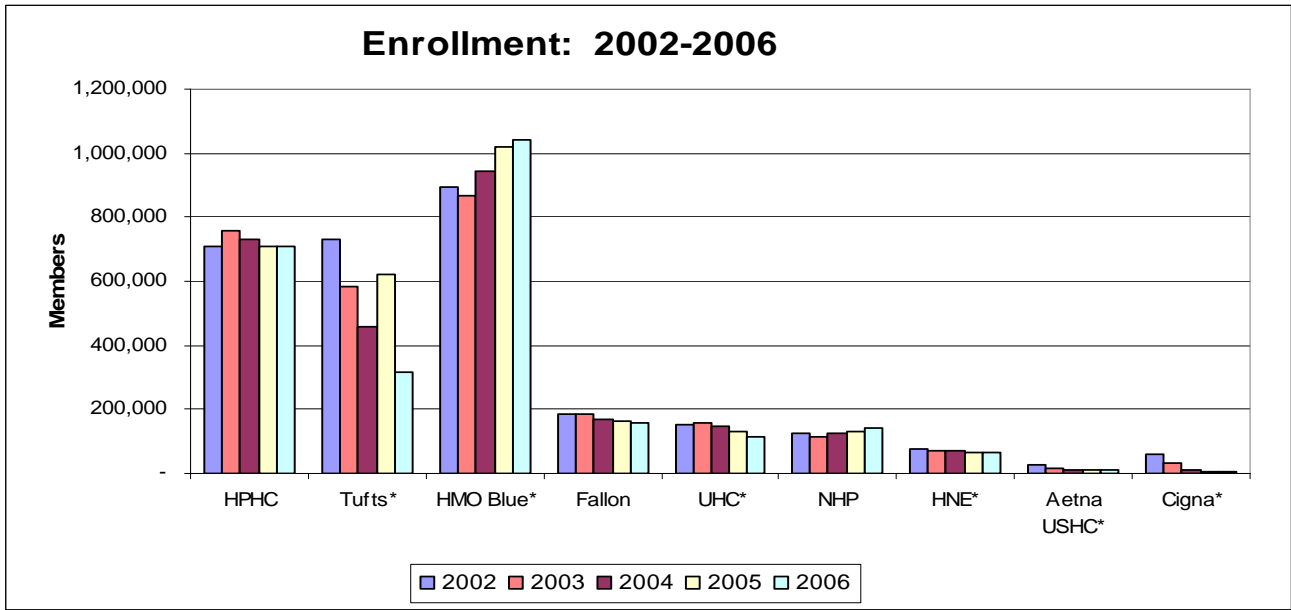


HMO Membership

Note: Enrollment data reported to the Division of Insurance do not include membership in self-insured (employer-insured) lines of business for some plans. BCBS, Fallon, HPHC and NHP numbers include self-insured members for all years reported. Aetna, CIGNA, HNE, HMO Blue, Tufts and United Health Care do not report self-insured members.

2006 Highlights

- Membership declined at all plans except BCBS and NHP.
- Blue Cross Blue Shield membership growth continued, with the addition of 225,000 new members. HMO Blue’s insured business grew by 22,000 members.
- NPH gained enrollment, adding nearly 12,000 new members.
- HPHC’s membership declined slightly.
- Tufts’s insured membership declined by 54,000 members, almost all in group business.
- United lost 17,000 members. Declines continued at CIGNA, which lost another 2,000 insured lives, and at AETNA/USHC, which lost 200 members.
