**Christy Dempsey**, MSN, CNOR, CENP, FAAN, Chief Nursing Officer, Press Ganey

Christina Dempsey is Chief Nursing Officer, responsible for providing clinical guidance to help clients transform the patient experience. She leads a team to reduce patient suffering and develop compassionate and connected care across the continuum.

In her present role, as well as previously as leader of clinical and operational consulting services for Press Ganey, Dempsey works to improve employee and physician engagement, improve the flow of patients throughout organizations, improve quality and efficiency, and prepare organizations for healthcare reform. She is a registered nurse with nearly three decades of healthcare experience in nursing, perioperative and emergency services management, medical practice, supply chain and materials management, and physician-hospital collaboration.

Dempsey frequently speaks and publishes nationally and internationally on patient experience, nursing, patient flow, physician-hospital collaboration, and balancing cost and quality. In November 2017, she released her first book, *The Antidote to Suffering: How Compassionate Connected Care Can Improve Safety, Quality, and Experience*, published by McGraw-Hill.

Sean Duffy is the co-founder and CEO of Omada Health, a digital behavioral medicine company dedicated to inspiring and empowering people everywhere to live free of chronic conditions like heart disease and type 2 diabetes. In 2016, Omada was named a Technology Pioneer by the World Economic Forum, and in 2015 the company was recognized as one of Fast Company's Most Innovative Companies.

An in-demand speaker and thought leader, Duffy's accolades include a spot on *The San Francisco Business Times'* 2015 list of "40 Under 40," *Diabetes Forecast* magazine's list of "2014 Diabetes All Stars," and JPMorgan's list of the "100 Most Intriguing Entrepreneurs of 2014."

Duffy's past speaking engagements include Clinton Global Initiative Health Matters Summit, SXSW Interactive, the Society for Behavioral Medicine, the JPMorgan Healthcare Conference, and others. He has written extensively about digital health and the future of healthcare in *The Wall Street Journal*, *Forbes*, *MedGadget*, and *TechCrunch*, among other publications.

Prior to Omada, Duffy worked at both Google and IDEO. A former MD/MBA candidate at Harvard, he holds a BS in neuroscience from Columbia University.

Greenwood brings to Google pharmaceutical, biotechnology, and digital health industry expertise in building innovative technology companies and providing strategic counsel to global corporations. Greenwood is on the Board of MassBio and IRX Therapeutics, and serves as Advisor to Dana-Farber Cancer Institute, as part of Business Development Council. She also lectures at Boston University Law School and School of Management. Her career has spanned leadership roles in venture, BD, company and product building, and law, previously serving as Venture Partner at Colt Ventures, leading BD and Strategy for a Flagship Ventures company, and serving as Senior Mergers & Acquisitions Counsel at Pfizer. Greenwood began her career practicing law at the national law firm, WilmerHale.



**Kim Lear**, Speaker, Writer, Strategist, Researcher, and True Generational Expert

NFL wide receiver, Brandon Marshall is one of the most influential figures in the mental health community. After being diagnosed with Borderline Personality Disorder in 2011, he co-founded PROJECT 375 to help promote awareness of mental health, end the stigma, and raise funding for treatment.



### ***Congressman Richard E. Neal***

Richard Neal was born in Worcester, Massachusetts on February 14, 1949, and was raised and educated in the City of Springfield. He is a 1972 graduate of American International College, where he received his bachelor's degree in political science and was a member of the National Honor Society. He received his masters degree in public administration from the Barney School of Business and Public Administration at the University of Hartford in 1976.

Neal was first elected to the United States House of Representatives in 1988. In January 2019, he became chairman of the powerful, tax-writing House Ways and Means Committee.

Congressman Neal is the dean of both the Massachusetts Delegation and the New England Congressional Delegation. He is a long-time guest lecturer at the University of Massachusetts in Amherst, a Trustee at Mount Holyoke College, and a National Trustee of the John F. Kennedy Library in Boston. He served as Mayor of the City of Springfield from 1984 to 1988, and was highlighted in *Newsweek* magazine for his many accomplishments during that time.

Congressman Neal has been a lead sponsor of legislation to prevent American companies from moving offshore to avoid paying U.S. taxes. He has sponsored legislation that would increase the national savings rate by encouraging the use of individual retirement accounts, and has worked to make healthcare and tuition expenses tax deductible for middle-class people. He successfully led the charge to eliminate the Alternative Minimum Tax for middle-class families in America. Neal has a long legislative history of fighting to preserve and protect Medicare and Social Security.

Congressman Neal is an At-Large Whip for the House Democrats. He is a co-chairman of the New England Congressional Caucus, where he advocates for the unique regional interests of the six New England States. Congressman Neal is the Democratic Leader of the Friends of Ireland Caucus.
