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## HEALTH LEADERSHIP COLLEGE

The Health Leadership College (HLC) has a strong 10+ year track record of preparing professionals for the highest level of leadership in healthcare.

The 2026 HLC is a purposeful collaboration between the Massachusetts Health & Hospital Association and Harvard Business School to provide leaders with the skills, knowledge, and networks they need to see healthcare organizations into the future.

## Program Overview & Curriculum

The program has two modules: Leadership Forums and Immersive Learning Experience.

### LEADERSHIP FORUMS

Leadership forums offer a series of networking dinners and candid, “off-the-record” conversations with guest speakers, including healthcare CEOs and other thought leaders.

Participants gain insight into the broader healthcare ecosystem and, through shared experiences, build networks they can leverage throughout their careers.

**Upon completion of the program, participants receive a certificate from Harvard Business School and from the Health Leadership College.**

### IMMERSIVE LEARNING EXPERIENCE

Core of the program: three-day residential immersive learning experience on the campus of Harvard Business School.

Taught by world-class Harvard Business School faculty.

Learning experience centers on highly interactive case method, teaching leaders how to think.

Participants apply skills and strategies to real-world challenges and resolve issues through discussion and debate.

Sessions include small group exercises and peer discussions with faculty, fostering enduring professional relationships and collaborative networks lasting far beyond the program.
